This cute quilt is the perfect beginner project, or a fun activity for an advanced quilter. You will learn about working with pre-cuts, accurate quarter inch seams, nesting seams, strip piecing, half square triangles, and pressing techniques. There will be a minimal amount of pre-cutting at home so we can begin sewing as soon as class starts. So, grab that jelly roll you love but didn't know what to do with, and come find out which way is up!

Depending on your quilting experience you will be able to finish one or more of each of the blocks and learn how they are put together to finish the quilt.

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 Jelly Roll or 40-2½" strips

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing Machine
 - Basic Sewing Kit: Scissors, seam ripper, pins, bobbin, ect.
 - Neutral thread
 - ¼" presser foot
 - Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
 - Cutting mat about 12"x18" or larger
 - Acrylic ruler approximately 3½"x12" and 6"x24"
 - Personal ironing surface and small iron (optional)
