

Cake Mini Quilt

Make this as scrappy or as planned as possible!!

All seams are 1/4"

Finished size is 6 1/2"



Supplies Needed:

- White fabric piece at least 7" x 8"
 - Sub cut: 2- 1 3/4 X 2" for top cake layer sides, 2- 1" X 3 1/4" for bottom cake layer and top of base, 2- 2" X 1" for bottom of base, use remaining white for paper piecing
- Cake Layers 1: 1-2"x4" piece for top layer, 1- 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" piece for bottom layer (your choice of color, sample was in pink and coral)
- Cake Stand: 4" x 4" piece aqua print
 - Sub cut: 3 1/2" x 1" for bottom of stand. Use remaining piece to paper piece stand
- Various trims, Extra Large ric-rack, regular ric-rack, ribbons and pom-poms to give fun finishes to cake
- Candle: 1 1/2" square of yellow fabric
- 7" square backing fabric
- 7" square of batting
- Aqua or other fabric cut to 2 1/2" x 30" and pressed in half lengthwise for binding
- Sewing Machine with matching thread
- Rotary Cutter, Ruler, and Mat
- Scissors

Directions:

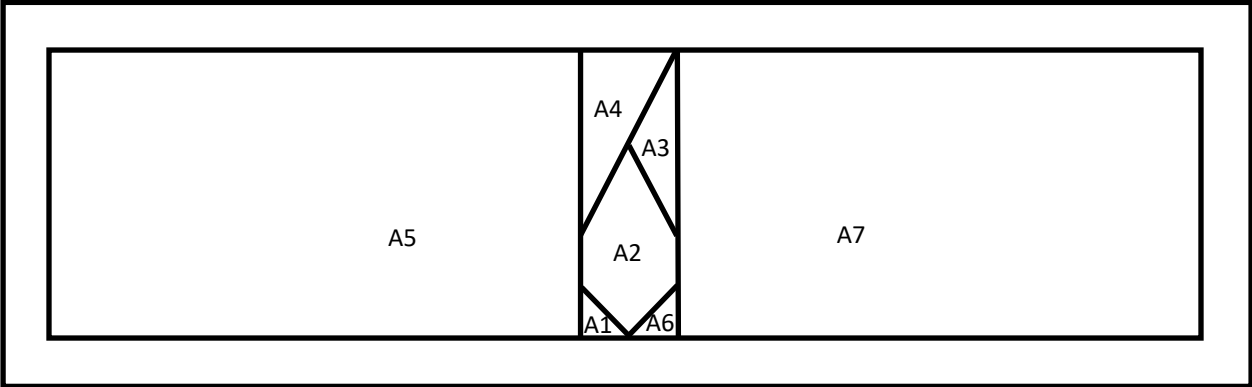
Only 2 pieces of this are paper pieced. Make them following numbers and set aside.

Sew trim to colored cake pieces. Stitch large ric-rack to the bottom of the bottom piece of cake so only scalloped side shows. Add the paper pieced cake stand. Stitch white 1" X 3 1/4" pieces to sides and trim ric-rack ends.

Sew other pieces together and add layers together as sample shows.

Trim to 6 1/2" square. Quilt and bind as desired.
