Turn one fabric into a show-stopping quilt! In this class, you'll discover the magic of the One Block Wonder technique, where a single print transforms into stunning kaleidoscope-style hexagon blocks. No two blocks are ever the same, and the results are always spectacular! Panels can also be used.

In this class you'll learn:

- How to select fabric that brings out the best kaleidoscope effect
- Tips for stacking, cutting, and piecing hexagons with ease
- Layout ideas to create movement and flow in your quilt
- Techniques for building a quilt top that is uniquely yours

Whether you're a confident beginner or an experienced quilter looking for a fresh project, this class is full of creativity, inspiration, and fun. Join us and see how one fabric can create endless possibilities!

Fabric Requirements:

- 6 repeats of a large-scale print (at least 24" repeat suggested, 6–7 yards total)

Or

- 6 of the same panel

Supplies Needed:

- Rotary Cutter & Mat (with a fresh blade for best results)
- Acrylic Ruler (6" × 24" recommended)
- 60° Triangle Ruler (8" or larger)
- Sewing Machine (in good working order, with power cord & foot pedal)
- Thread, Scissors, Pins/Clips
- Extra Bobbins & Needles
- Large vinyl FLANNEL backed tablecloth (optional, but very helpful for arranging blocks)
