### Fabric Requirements:

#### House ( to make 1 )

3 x 6 inch beige wool felt for gingerbread house

2 x 3 inch white wool felt for snow roof

Scraps of colored felt for doors, windows, candy canes, snowman, etc.

Seed beads & embellishments

Embroidery thread

Fine glitter

#### Christmas Tree ( to make 1 )

3 x 4 inch green felt for tree

Scraps of light brown felt for trunk

Embroidery thread

Seed beads & embellishments

Serrated scissors, glue stick or sequins pins, pencil, embroidery & beading needle, thimble, narrow ribbon for ornament loop (optional)

Wool balls for garland (optional)

### Supplies Needed:

- Serrated scissors
- glue stick or sequins pins,
- Pencil
- embroidery & beading needle,
- Thimble
- narrow ribbon for ornament loop (optional)

If you are making a garland out of the Gingerbread houses & Christmas trees I will provide the wool Balls.
