In this class, we'll take the mystery out of paper piecing and walk you through step by step. You'll learn how to:

- Read and organize paper piecing patterns
 Position and stitch fabrics for perfect points every time
- Trim, press, and join sections with confidence
- Explore creative designs only possible with FPP

Whether you're brand new to paper piecing or want to polish your skills, you'll leave class with new techniques, tips, and a project you'll be proud to show off. Paper piecing opens up a whole new world of quilt designs—come join us and give it a try!

Fabric Requirements:

 Tattoo Quilt block Patterns are sold separately or in a full quilt set, Stitch On Banner sold separately. (one block pattern required per student) Pattern: Happysewlucky shop on Etsy

Fabric for Quilt

- Assorted solids or prints for blocks (fat quarters or scraps work well)
- Background fabric: approx. 4 yards (depending on layout size)
- Accent fabric for banners: 1–2 yards (bright colors recommended)
- Backing, batting, and binding (optional for class, needed for finishing)

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing machine (with power cord, foot pedal, extra needles & bobbins)
- Rotary cutter & mat (fresh blade recommended)
- Acrylic ruler (6" × 12" is a nice size)
- Add-an-Eigth Ruler
- Small scissors or thread snips
- Thread
- Pins or clips
- Seam ripper
- glue stick
- Scotch tape
