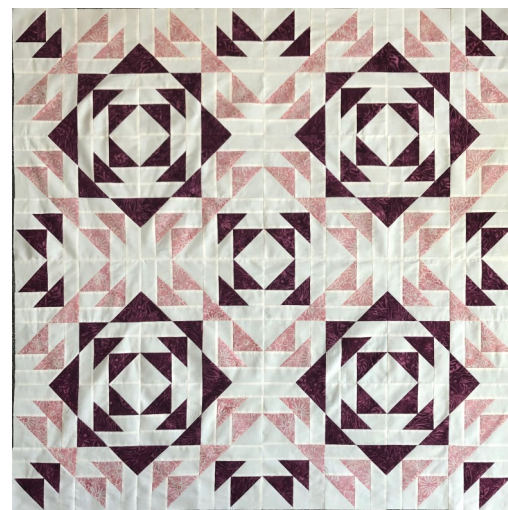

Learn to make Flying Geese on the diagonal by adding logs and triangles to a starting square or half square triangle. We will use the Tucker Trimmer and Wing Clipper tools to cut and trim the blocks perfectly. After making a few of these blocks, use your pattern to choose from 9 different layouts and 5 different quilt sizes to make your masterpiece. There are lots of possibilities. We will learn techniques for perfectly matching corners and diagonal lines when sewing blocks together; and for pressing seams to make the combined blocks lay flat. It's fun to make these blocks and turn them different directions and see how the pattern changes. You will love this creative process. In class we will finish several of the individual building blocks and begin setting them together in your choice of design. It is so fun to watch these come together.

Fabric Requirements:

- A minimum of 2 yards of dark fabric and 2 yards of high contrast background fabric. Specific requirements will be sent depending on how many colors of fabric you prefer (You need 1 background and 1-3 additional colors).

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing Machine
- Basic Sewing Kit: Scissors, seam ripper, pins, bobbin, ect.
- Neutral thread
- 1/4" presser foot
- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- Cutting mat about 12"x18" or larger
- Acrylic ruler approximately 3 1/2"x12" and 6"x24"
- Personal ironing surface and small iron (optional)
- Studio 180 Designs Tools:
 - Tucker Trimmer
 - Wing Clipper
