Class Description:

These houses are perfect for every season, holiday, or just everyday decorating. Come learn some of the tricks to add personality and create a 3-D décor in your favorite fabric! The largest house measures approx 7 1/2" tall, 4" wide and 2" deep. The medium house finishes at 6 1/2" tall by 3" wide and 1 1/2" deep. When finished, the small house measures 5" tall, 2 1/2" wide and 1 1/2" deep.

Fabric Requirements:

3-4 fat quarters for houses, fabric scraps for windows/doors/trim. Notes on fabric: small applique pieces
work best with solids/ tone on tone or very small print fabrics. Select fabric with enough contrast
between the house fabric and the applique to be sure the applique will be seen.

Or order the kit which includes enough supplies to create 3 houses.

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing Machine and coordinating thread
- Basic Sewing Kit (seam ripper, measuring tape, scissors, ect.)
- Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting board
- Iron/ ironing table or wool mat
- Fusible Adhesive- needs to be sewable. I recommend Printable Heat n Bond Lite
- Stuffing
- Card stock or chip board (you can use cereal boxes or cardboard boxes for this as well)
- Rice, beans or walnut shells to create weighted bottom.
