Class Description:

In this class we can make Unicorns, Donkeys, Horses, Gnomes, Gingerbread Man, Bats, Pumpkins, Skeletons, Cats... the possibilities are endless!!This class can go in so many directions! We will cover the basics of doll body construction and some tips to make it a smoother process. Then, we will spend time making accessories and clothes. You will be hooked when you find out how easy it is!

Fabric Requirements:

- Body Shapes 1/3 yard fabric
- Scraps to fat guarters.: To make other items like noses, horns, ears, wings, ect....
- Fiber fill

Supplies Needed:

- Printed pattern (If I purchase patterns in bulk, They will be cheaper and can be printed to pick up in class) We will be talking about tips for your patterns when cutting.
- Sewing Machine
- Basic Sewing Kit, including pins, scissors, and marking pen
- Pinking Shears (these are a must!)
- Doll Needles
- Coordinating Thread
- Purple Thang, chopstick or knitting needle for turning



Body Kits and clothing kits will be available closer to class based on fabric availability. Pricing will be sent prior to class to ensure you get the kits you want. We can also order patterns in bulk for the best discount.
