

Trailer Mini Quilt

All fabrics used in sample are Outlined at below.

All seams are 1/4"

Finished size is 6"

Supplies Needed:

Several pieces of desired fabric to cover all pattern pieces

7" square of batting

7" square of fabric for backing

30" x 2" fabric for binding

Add a quarter ruler for paper piecing

Paper piecing paper for printing heart

Sewing Machine with matching thread

Rotary Cutter, Ruler, and Mat

10" Bakers Twine for Banner

1" x 4" Steam a Seam for banner pieces

Small button

White Embroidery Floss for hand stitching

Directions:

Start piecing pattern pieces and attach as shown on the diagrams. Press all seams open after stitching grouped pieces together. After all pieces are sewn and pressed, carefully remove all paper.

Place pieced block on top of batting and backing to make a mini quilt sandwich. Quilt as desired. Hand quilt if desired. Trace 4 banner pieces on Steam a Seam and press to back side of 4 of your favorite fabrics. Fold fabric in half WST and cut to shape using pattern pieces. Fold over baker's twine and press RST. Tie ends of bakers twine in a knot with 1 1/2" tails. Stitch in place.

Add button to door. Bind as desired.

Color Selection from original paper pieced trailer:

Light Gray Pieces 1, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, and 15

White: Pieces 2, 4, 9, 16, 18, 19, 21, 22, 23, and 24

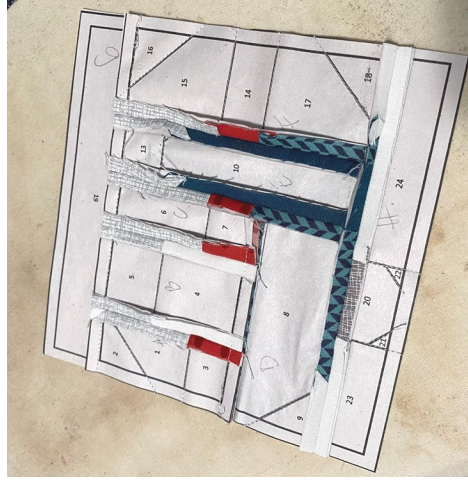
Red: 3, 7, and 14

Dark Aqua: 10

Medium Aqua: 8 and 17

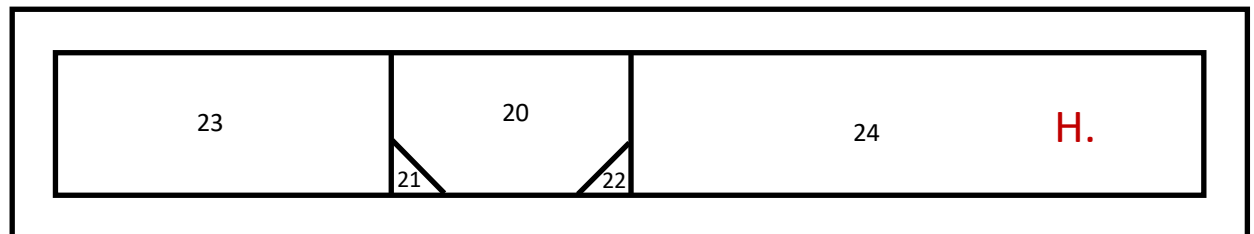
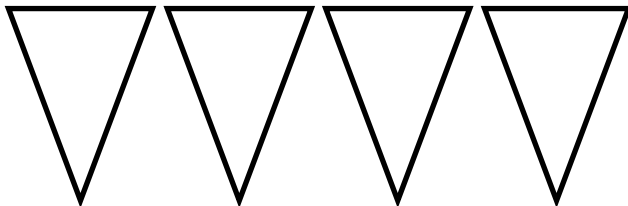
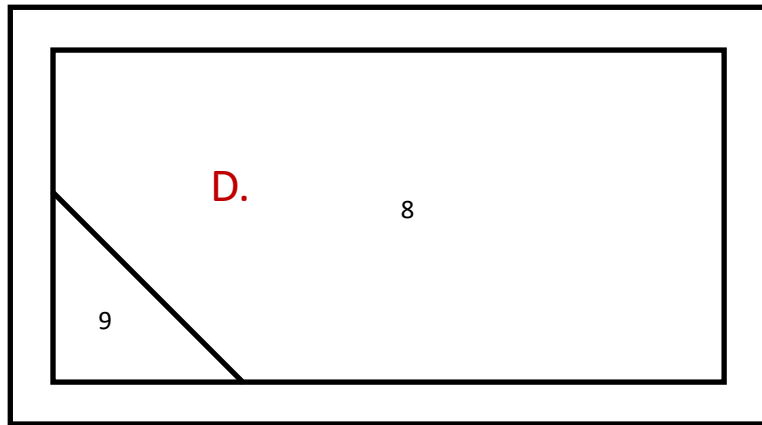
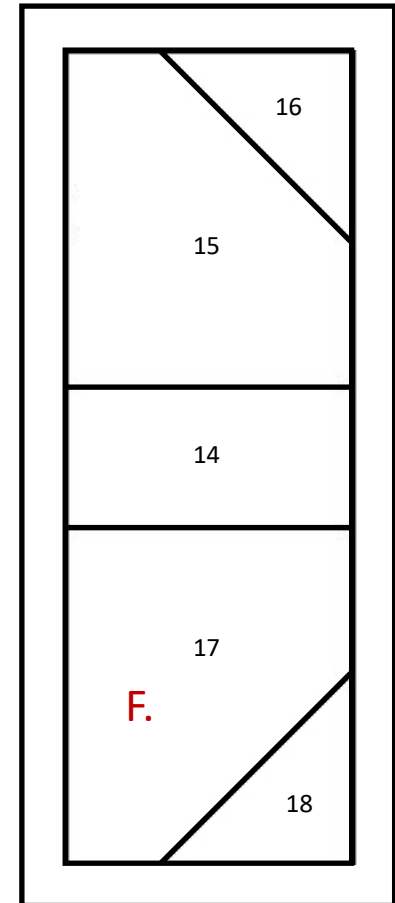
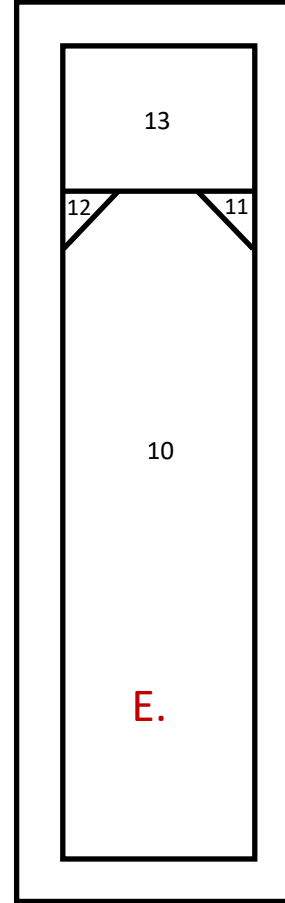
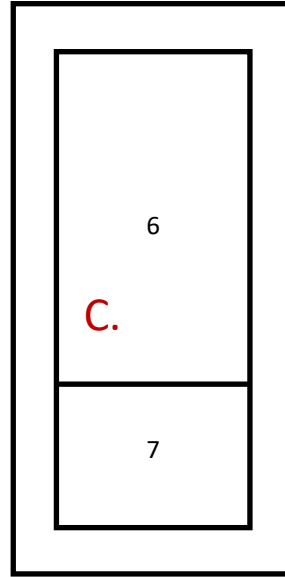
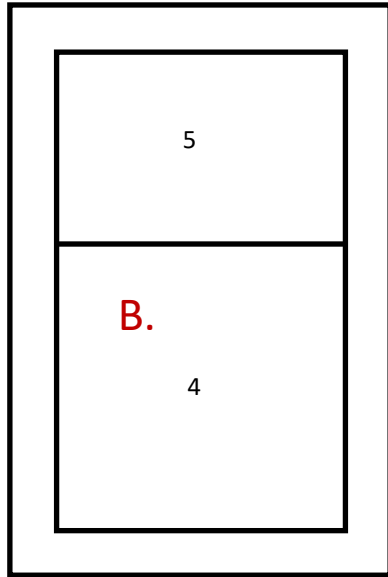
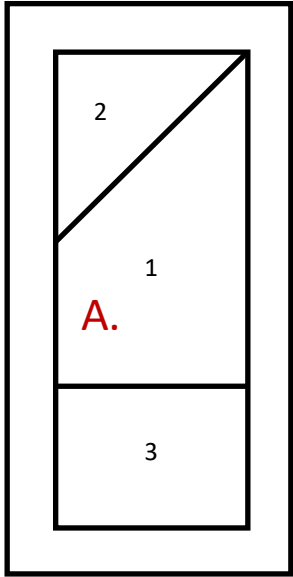
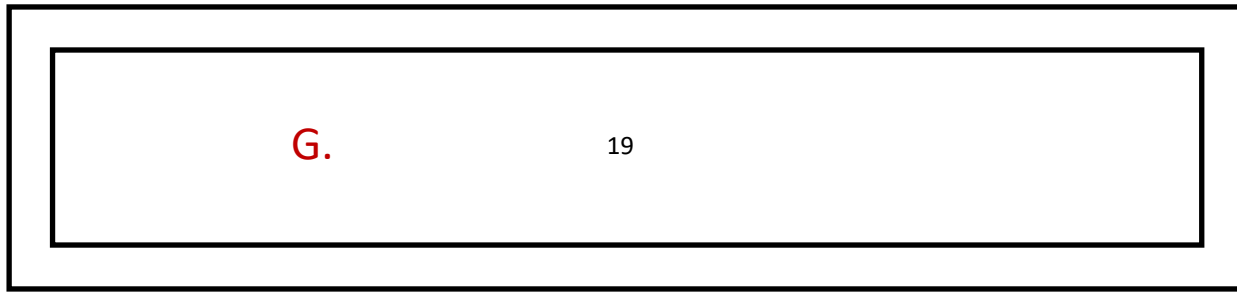
Dark Gray: 20

Banner: Small scraps of Red, Green, Pink and Aqua.

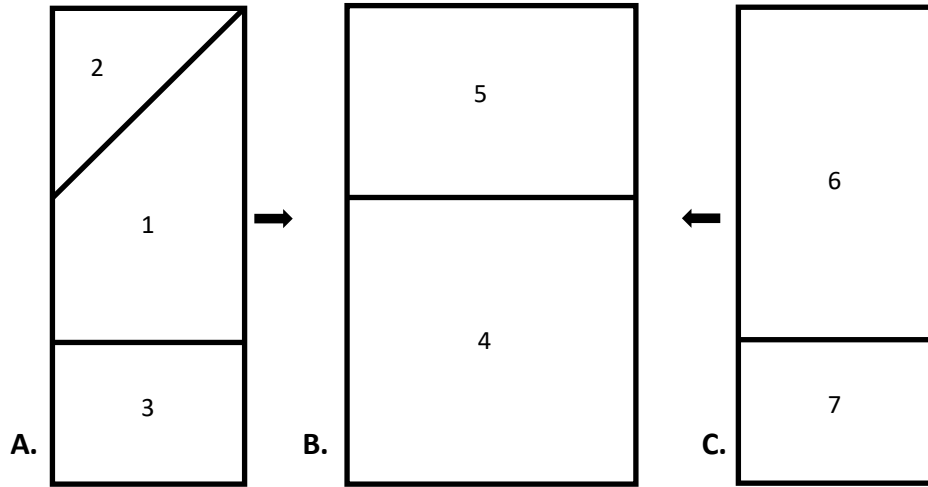


Trailer Pattern

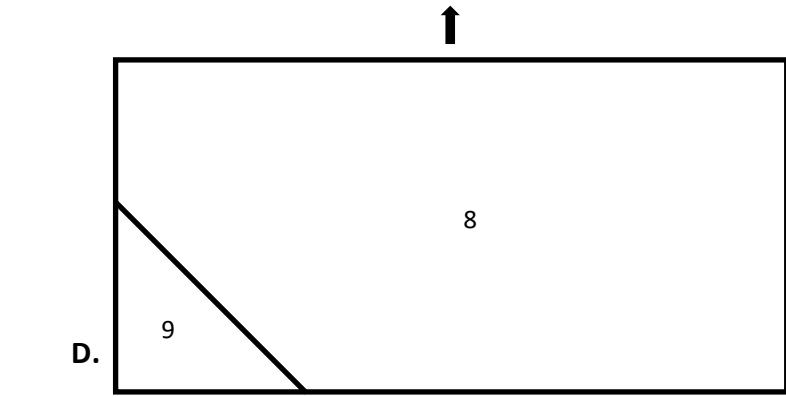
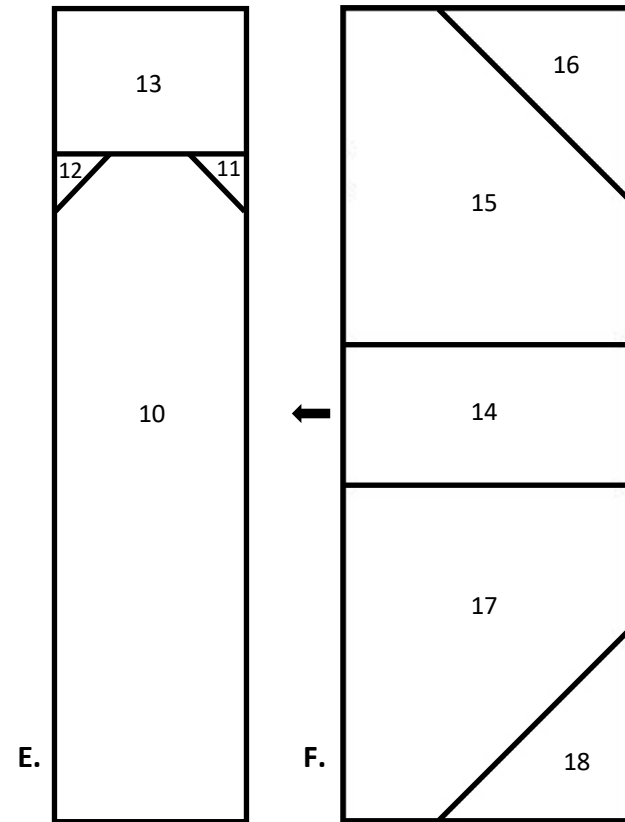
Pieces



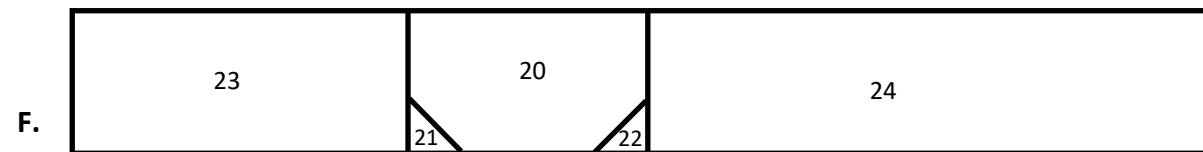
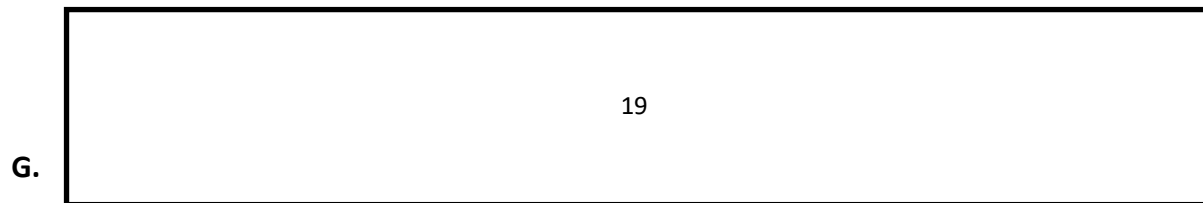
1. Create pieces A, B, and C and stitch together following arrows.

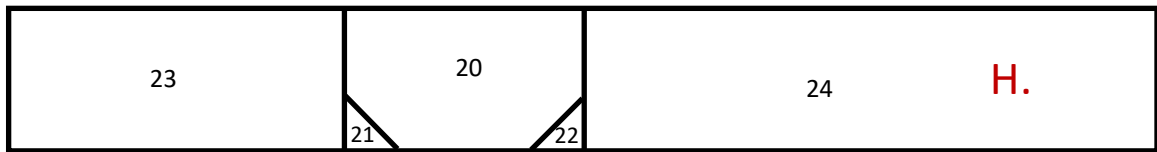
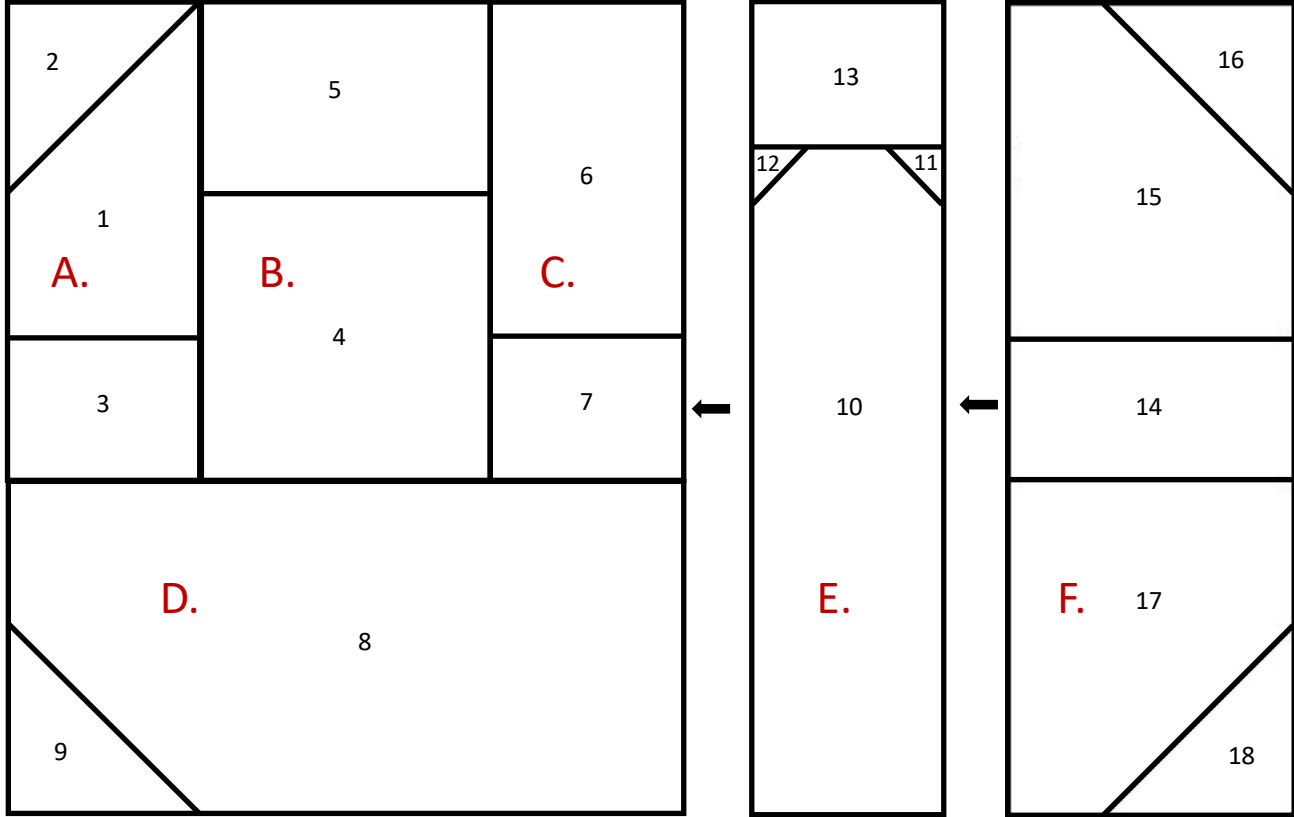
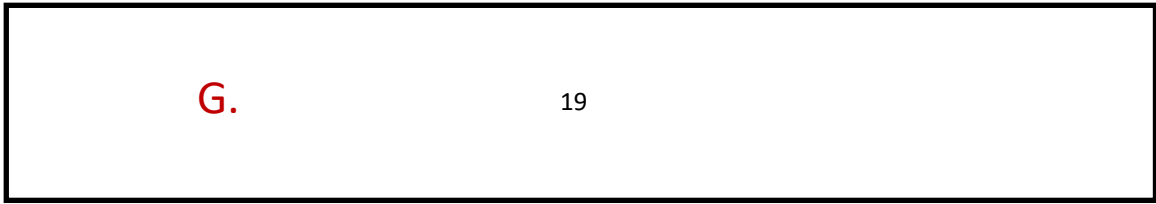


3. Create pieces E and F, stitch together following arrows and attach. Then add to side of A/B/C/D Piece to create trailer. Then add G to top and F to bottom.

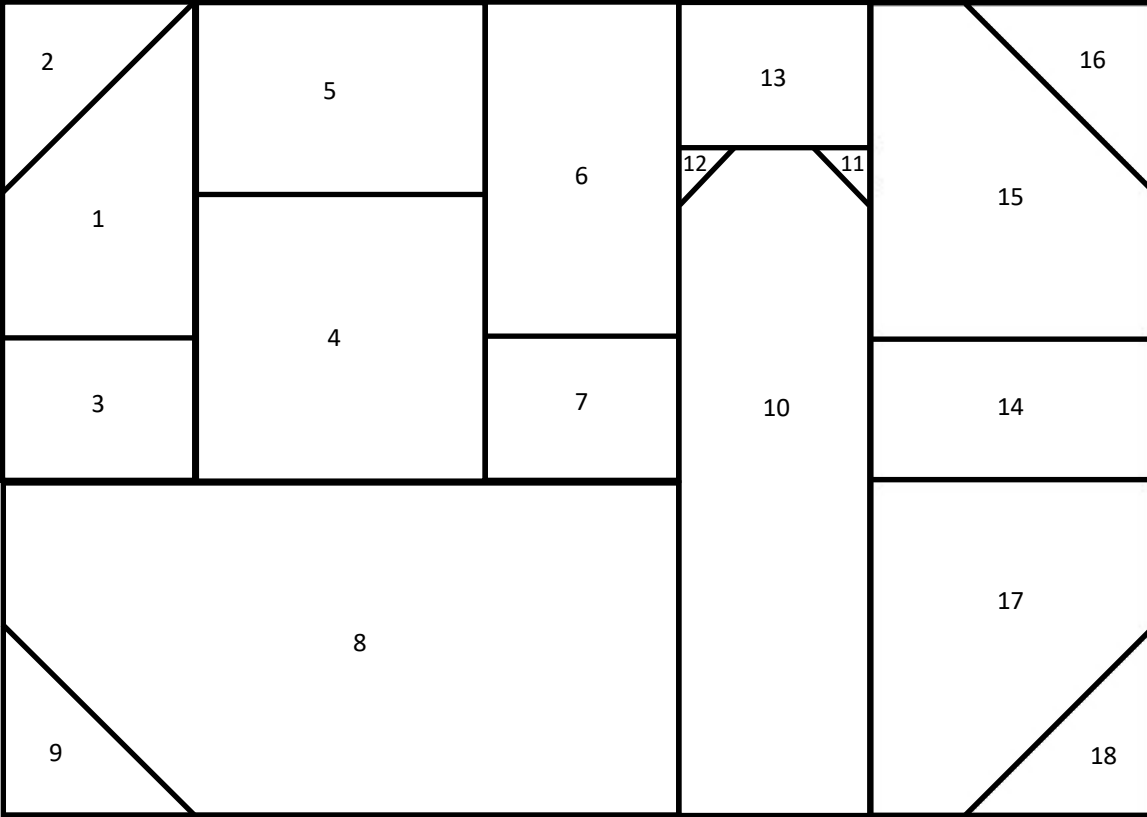
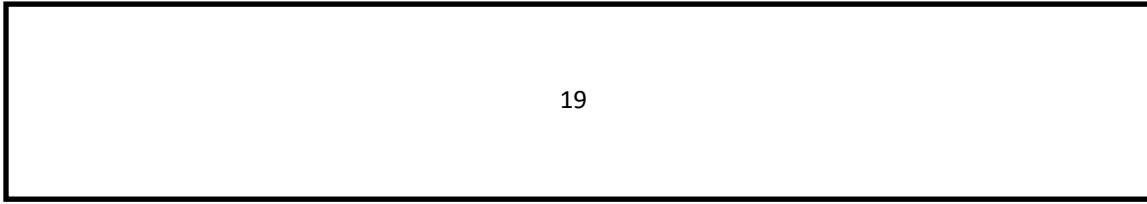


2. Create piece D and add to the bottom of the A/B/C piece.
