Have you ever wanted to make a lone star but it seems intimidating? Ever wanted to try your hand at making a Christmas tree skirt? This class combines both, but you can keep the lone star and use it in a quilt instead. Jennifer has made dozens of lone stars, taught classes, and

designed quilt patterns using lone stars. She loves making them and will guide you in doing the same. This pattern uses a strip piecing method, which helps simplify both construction and fabric placement. She will share her tips for accurate piecing, show you how to sew a y-seam for the background pieces, and how to finish the tree skirt.

- Sewing Machine and thread
- Basic Sewing Kit: (Scissors, seam ripper, pins, bobbin, ect.)
- Embroidery floss and needle
- rotary cutter, ruler and cutting board
- Iron/ ironing table or wool mat
- scissors
